





(Non-immigrant ED Visa) - Thai student visa

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


Required documents to the OIA:

in order to issue a request letter

Acceptance letter from MAIDS-GRID programme Vaccine certificate (at least 2 doses) health insurance copy of passport





Normally when the embassy grants foreigners a visa, that visa will be valid for 90 days or 3 months for them to enter Thailand.

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

Please note

Foreigners can request a visa extension of up to 1 year (per round) at the immigration office at Chaengwattana for 45 days before the expiry date. However, for student cases, the length of extension also depends on the academic year or semester they registered.

For the visa extension, students are required to submit a request letter issued by the OIA. The process at the OIA may take at least 2 weeks, every student must check their visa and contact the faculty's international affairs staff at least one month in advance. If you are a MAIDS student, the first extension will be until the end of the academic year, for this round will be on 4 August 2023. And later than that you can request a visa extension per a trimester you register.

If you are a GRID student, during 3 academic years, you will get a one-year extension(per time) until the third academic year. And later than that you can request a visa extension per a trimester you register. Required documents for Non-ED Visa Extension:

1. Application form (TM7)

2.1 passport photo (4x6 cm)

3. Fee (1,900 Baht)

4.A photocopy of the passport

5.A photocopy of the page of the visa expiry date

6.A departure card (TM 6 card)

7.A letter issued by Chulalongkorn University in support of the application

8. Acknowledgment of terms and conditions for a permit of temporary stay in the Kingdom of Thailand

9. Acknowledgment of penalties for a visa overstay 10. Academic transcript

11. Accommodation contract

12. A report letter issued by the faculty of the student's affiliation on the total class



Any students who continue staying in Thailand after the expiry date without a visa extension will be overstayed. Any overstay will cost 500 baht per day but not exceed the amount of 20,000 baht or in the worst case, they are banned to enter the country.

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NOTICE ALIEN WHOEVER STAYS IN THE KINGDOM LONGER THAN 90 DAYS SHALL, MAKE NOTIFICATION

Any Alien received a temporary stay shall notify place of residence to competent official at Immigration Division or Immigration office in that area at every 90 days. If an alien, having submitted an application (TM.7) for extension of temporary stay, that alien shall be allowed to use that application as a notification of residence, for the first time in the 90 days period. The alien will however be required to subsequently report every ninety days.

According to Immigration Act B.E.2522, Section 76, any alien who fails to comply with this notice, shall be punished with a fine not exceeding 5,000 Baht and with an additional fine not exceeding 200 Baht for each day this passed until the law is complied with.



This 90 day report is not related to the visa extension, every time you extend your visa, you must always check the slip of the notification of 90 days report, otherwise, you will be punished with a fine according to the immigration bureau act.

Those students who want to leave Thailand for a short/long-term visit during their visa are still valid, if their current visa is a single entry, they must apply for a re-entry permit at the immigration office in order to come back to Thailand. Otherwise, your visa will be automatically suspended once you leave the country.

Required documents for Re-Entry permit

1. Application form (TM.8)

2.1 passport photo (4x6 cm)

3. A photocopy of the page of the visa expiry date

4.A departure card

5. Fee (1,000 Baht for a single re-entry and 3,800 Baht for a multiple re-entry)

6. Photocopy of the passport



If you are going to graduate from MAIDS-Grid or resign from the programme or work in a company in Thailand, you must cancel your current non-ed visa.

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Foreigners can contact the immigration office to cancel their visas 21 days before the expiry date. For MAIDS-GRID students 21 days before their student status end. **Required documents for Visa Cancellation**

- 1. Request letter for visa cancellation issued by the OIA, Chula
- 2. transcript CR25+ a letter certifies that you've completed all coursework, submitted the thesis, and waiting for the faculty committee's approval for graduation. This letter will be signed by the faculty registrar.
- Photocopies of: 3.
 - Departure Card (TM6)
 - Passport bio page
 - ED visa page
 - Exit stamp (if any)
 - Latest entrance stamp/visa

For the graduation case, the last date to submit the visa cancellation and stay in Thailand is the day that your graduation request is submitted to the faculty committee and approved.

Students must inform the programme coordinator and the international affairs staff about their graduation plan for at least 2 months in advance, so the staff can help them get prepared for this step.
